Two Board Positions to Be Filled at This May's Election

The terms of two of our board members, Dave Burden and Ben Novograd, expire at the end of May. This leaves two board positions to be filled at this May's election. The club bylaws require us to prepare and distribute the election ballots to current members by two weeks before the election party; to do this, we need candidate information by the end of April. Ballots will be mailed during the first week of May.

Bike Rides to Resume in April

As in past years, we'll be resuming the morning club bike rides in April. The rides are usually on local bike trails, typically between 20 and 30 miles long. Later in the season, we also periodically join the Thursday evening taco ride on the Wabash Trace trail from Council Bluffs to Mineola. Bike ride messages are sent by email to all club members in the local area several days before each ride. This timing allows planning for weather conditions. The club will also again be participating in several large charity-sponsored bike rides, such as the Wear Yellow Ride, Rollin to Colon, Omaha With Lights, Corporate Cycling Challenge, and the Wish Ride. These rides are usually announced one to two months in advance. They typically have a range of ride lengths from 10 to over 100 miles, entry fees of \$20 to \$30, and are usually not rescheduled for bad weather. Email announcements for charity bike rides will usually be sent around six weeks in advance to give people time to register for them.
