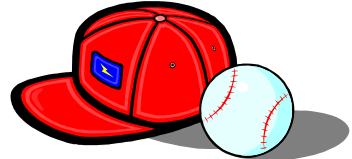

This includes two runs down the NASTAR course. It is a good warm-up for Friday's Challenge Races. Phil was our only participant in this race. His time was 39.77 on the course which was a Bronze NASTAR medal. Next was the Team Relay Race, known as the "Snowshoe" race. This year we only had one team. Eric, Lamont, Dave and Kim competed. Others gathered to observe the fun. I did show up to take photos. Our team did a great job and placed seventh. This was great, considering we do this once a year.

Friday, we had the Challenge Races. Eleven members raced for team points. I gave Phil my camera and told him to do what he could. I wasn't able to help out as I had planned. I missed seeing everyone go down the race course. In the men's race, Pat Connelly received a Bronze NASTAR medal and Phil received the third place medal for his age bracket.

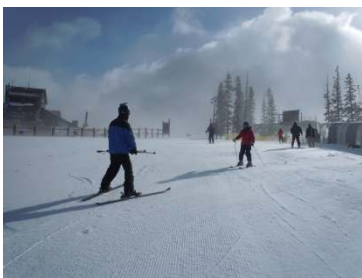
