Trips Update October 2023

It sounds like the same pitch this month as last, but if you wish to go on a trip, there are limited spots available. I know the procrastinators and you know who you are! I try my best to keep the spots, but cannot risk the club funds holding spaces. Please do not wait until January to sign up for Steamboat.

- One spot left for SNOWMASS! This can be either male or female. Last chance to sign up! Dates are December 10-15, 2023. The cost is \$550 plus lift tickets, if you are not an IKON Pass holder. If you do need lift tickets, you have only until October 31, 2023 to sign-up. This is a drive-out trip. See Trips Flyer
- Next, FSA will be going to **Steamboat** January 20-27, 2024. The cost of the trip is \$1185 plus lift tickets if you are not an IKON pass holder. This is a week-long trip. We will be staying at the Timber Run Condos which are 2- or 3-bedroom condos with full kitchens. They have private shuttles to the mountain. The outdoor hot tubs are nice! There are only 22 spots. We have 18 signed up so far. THERE ARE **ONLY 4** SPOTS LEFT. DON'T wait to the last minute as I may be dropping the 4 spots before then, if we cannot fill this trip! See trip flyer for more information.
- Early February, we will be going to **Taos NM** February 4-9, 2024. The cost of the trip is \$430 plus lift tickets. We have booked 12 spots at the Hampton Inn in Taos. We have 9 signed up. There are **3 spots left at this time**. This is a drive out trip.
- In February, CMSC will be going to **Banff, Alberta, Canada** for a week 2/24-3/2/2024. See trip flyer for pricing. We will coordinate air & transfers with CMSC. You will need a passport. We are staying in the town of Banff at the Caribou Lodge. The town is a great place to explore if you are a non-skier. All three of the mountains (Sunshine, Mt Norquay and Lake Louise) are on IKON (SKIBIG3). The pricing includes lift tickets, so it will be less if you have an IKON pass. We have 23 signed up. ONE spot left for a male. If you wish to join us, let me know.

I am keeping an eye on airfare. It is horribly expensive in order to get us in to Calgary in the afternoon. It does get less expensive to get in at 11:30 PM, but we would not have transfers. If you book your own air, please send the itinerary to me. I am still looking for options. It is very cheap from Denver!

I am still looking to get a trip together for March...stay tuned. I still am trying....



OMAHA SKI CLUB TRIP POLICIES

- 1) Trip captain is the final authority on and during the trip.
- 2) Club members will conduct themselves in a mature manner at all times.
- 3) There will be a \$28.00 charge (subject to change according to bank fees) on any returned check.

TRIP SIGN-UP, DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS

- 4) Only members in good standing with dues currently paid to the Omaha Ski Club may sign up for a trip. Children under the age of 19 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian on the trip. A trip application for a child under the age of 19 must be signed by a parent or guardian of the child
- 5) By signing up for a trip a member agrees to pay the Club the full cost of the trip applied for, subject to the provisions for timely cancellation in item #7. Each trip will have its own trip deposit and payment schedule to be set by the trip committee. A deposit is required to sign up for a trip. Failure to meet the payment schedule may result in automatic cancellation from the trip subject to the cancellation fee in item #7.
- 6) When a trip is full the trip captain will start a waiting list. To be placed on the waiting list a member must fill out and sign a trip application and pay the standard deposit for that trip. Waiting list members must meet the payment schedules when moving to the confirmed lists.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

- 7) Unless otherwise listed in individual trip information, cancellations prior to 60 days before the trip departs will result in a cancellation fee of \$50.00; cancellations less than 60 days before the trip departs will result in a cancellation fee of \$100.00 if the trip goes full, or liability for the full cost of the trip if the trip does not go full. Any cancellation fees or penalties may first be deducted from payments the member made for the trip. Medical cancellations will be reviewed by the Board for refund determination. 8) Transferring from the waiting list on one trip to a
- confirmed list on another trip will be done with no cancellation fee. Refusal to move from the waiting list to the confirmed list will constitute automatic cancellation subject to the cancellation fee in item #7 above.
- 9) If a trip is cancelled by the club, all money paid to the club by a member for that trip will be refunded.
- 10) All members on the waiting list when the trip departs will receive a full refund.
- 11) No refunds will be made until after the trip returns.
